SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The NSA reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per lot; and
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the works mentioned in Section III, by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, where applicable;
- (b) the Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment as deemed appropriate

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your Quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be **120 days** from the date of bid submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) The bidder must submit a detailed quotation on its company letterhead, in addition to Section III List of Goods and Price Schedule
- (b) have an original or certified copy of the company Registration Certificate;
- (c) have an original or certified copy of a valid good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (d) have an original or certified copy of a valid good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (e) have a valid certified copy of the Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from the Employment Equity Commissioner that the bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (f) Submit a valid bid signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- (g) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-

clause 4.6 of the General Conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof; and;

- (h) Have a certified copy of a valid good standing BIPA Certificate.
- (i) All the mandatory documents in terms of section 50(2) of the Public Procurement Act, 2015 (Act No 15 of 2015) as amended, should be valid at the closing date of the bid or after.
- (j) The principal business should be in line with the nature of the service required.

5. Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration

6. Works Completion Period

The completion period for works shall be within 3 weeks after acceptance and issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in completion period shall not be accepted/shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at **Namibia Statistics Agency, FGI House, Post Street Mall, Ground Floor at Reception area**, not later than **07 March 2025, 11h00**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach **Namibia Statistics Agency** by the same date and time at the latest. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Security/Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening

10. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

11. Technical Compliance

The Specifications and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the works to be carried out. The specifications have to be met, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

12. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices for the execution of works shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted. Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the works, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the works shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental works shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.

- Closing of windows with steel sheets.
- Foam sealant to fill all the existing holes
- Supply and paint the server room with fire-resistant paint inside and outside
- Remove existing ceiling
- Install raised floors for the entire room
- Supply and install server room fireproof door and label “Server room : Authorised entry only”.
- Supply and install power and data cable management trays in the roof and under raised floor.
- Supply and replace door locks for all the mini server rooms on the floors
- Supply and install x20 10G SFP/GBICS for the server room and the floors.
- Migrate server room temperature monitoring system from DPC to Mutual plaza.
- Move server room equipment (Server and networking Cabinets from HQ & DP to Mutual Plaza).
- Cabling and labelling of all server room power and data cables.
- Supply and install uplink and down link fiber optic cables and transceivers enabling optimal speed of a minimum of 10GB/S from the main server room to all the identified mini server rooms on the identified floors.
- Fiber optic cables must be of Single-mode type up to 9 mm diameter.
- Install fiber protective enclosure tube for each cable
- Label and test all the cables to ensure 100% functionality.
- Provide a comprehensive report on all work done.
- Remove all redundant equipment and material (Nitrogen cylinders, etc)
- Clean the room
- Remove existing Air conditioners from server room and seal areas
- Provide a comprehensive report on all work done.

Lot 2: Relocation of air conditioners

- Uninstall x4 air conditioners at NSA head office & x2 at DPC server rooms and install them at Mutual Platz building server room.
- Provide a comprehensive report on all work done.

Lot 3: Relocation of UPS

- Uninstall the UPS's and all its components from DPC & Head Office and install them at the Mutual Plaza building as an integrated system.
- Setup the electricity distribution board with circuit breakers in the server room at mutual plaza.

- Test and ensure that sufficient electricity is provided to all equipment in the server room
