The Namibia Statistics Agency (NSA) was established in terms of the Statistics Act No. 9 of 2011, as a custodian of Official and Other Statistics. The Agency is piloting the assessment of Statistics for a possible Official Statistics designation.

The NSA requires the services of Labour Statistics Experts as follows. The terms of reference (ToR) are available on the NSA website.

► Job Purpose:

The Labour Statistics Experts will constitute a panel to assess Labour Statistics submitted for the piloting of the Guideline for the Assessment of Statistics component of the Namibia Quality Assurance Framework for Statistics (NQAFS).

► Key responsibilities include:

- Conduct an evidence-based independent assessment of Labour Statistics using official Assessment Guidelines and Tools.
- Verify compliance of the Labour Statistics with the dimensions of Official Statistics.
- Recommend to the Statistician-General in a timely manner the status of Official Statistics designation.
- Maintain strict confidentiality and impartiality throughout the assessments period.

► Job Requirements:

- A master's degree or higher in Statistics, Demography, Economics, or any labour-related fields.
- A minimum of 8 years' experience in labour statistics production.
- Must not have been in the employment of the NSA for the last 3 years.

Interested individuals may submit their applications, accompanied by a detailed CV and certified copies of relevant educational qualifications through online recruitment system NSA E-recruitment system. All qualifications obtained outside Namibia must be evaluated by the Namibia Qualification Authority (NQA).
